## Host Preparation

Here are a few tips to help you prepare yourself and your cast for the murder mystery.

Read the Guide on How to Host a Host-Party Murder Mystery. This guide will give you all the specifics on preparing for and hosting your party. This guide should have been emailed to you upon purchase. It is also available from the Materials menu on the Host-Party website.

## Guest Instructions

Playing one of our murder mysteries requires no special acting abilities, just a willingness to have fun. Our site gives you all the details you need to prepare for the party including character descriptions of all guests, internal information about your character (do not reveal this to others), and costume/prop recommendations.

During the party, each of you will be given clues. The clues provide all the information required to unlock the mystery. Each clue is designated as a clue to be concealed or a clue to be revealed. Conceal clues are generally information about your character that you try to hide (without lying) from the others. Reveal clues are ones that you should share with others in casual conversation.

During the party, guests will mingle around asking questions about each other's character and about clues you have received. As the game progresses, you will gather more and more information and at the end of the allotted time you will need to sift through fact and fiction to decide who is the murderer.

The characters can be played to suit the comfort zone of each player. If you like the spotlight or enjoy role playing, immerse yourself in your character's persona and live the night as you think they would. You may even decide to exaggerate your character's personality for even more effect. On the other hand, if you prefer to participate in a less theatrical capacity, you may want to sit on the couch and let people come to you, approach each character off to the side or just listen in on other conversations until you get your feet wet and are feeling a bit more comfortable.

There are only a few simple rules to follow when playing our games.

1. Stay in Character. (Costumes are highly recommended)
2. Hide/Stretch the truth, but don't lie!
3. Interrogate others.

Each game takes approximately 1-1/2 to 3 hrs, depending on the number of people playing.

## Round 1 - Sudden Death Cocktail

### Round Instructions

Place the Snobwood Country Club sign on the front of the bar and say "Welcome to the Snobwood C.C.". Set up your bar as if a murder is announced during the cocktail party by you received.

### General Clue (Share with all Guests)

During the cocktail party the host receives a phone call that a murder occurred at the club's caddy shack. He then reveals to the guests who the victim is.

## Round 1 Clue for Hal Tuplay Golf Trivia & Reveal Clue

To all that will listen, tell this golf story about Roger:

Roger was playing off the sixth tee at Snobwood last week. As all of you know, the fairway of the sixth needs some skill because it runs alongside the road. But Roger sliced the ball badly and it disappeared over the hedge bordering the road.

After the round, he was having a beer in the bar when I joined him. "Excuse me Roger, but was it you who sliced this ball into the road from the sixth tee box this morning?"

Roger responded, "Yes, but I took the penalty, I swear." I said, "That may be, but you might be interested to know that your ball hit and killed a small boy on a tricycle; the tricycle fell in the path of a Mountie on a motorcycle. He skidded and was thrown through the window of a car, killing the nun at the wheel. Her car then swerved into a cement mixer which wasn't too damaged but had to veer slightly and in doing so ran into the local school bus, and with such an impact it sent it flying through the window of the nearby shopping centre. At last count from the hospital there are thirteen people dead and seventy-nine people seriously injured."

Roger then turned a deathly shade of white and said, "O my god, what can I do?"

I said; "Well, you could try moving your left hand a little bit further down the shaft."

### REVEAL CLUE:

Mingle among the guests and talk about the championship tournament and how exciting it was when Bo Jay sank a 45 foot putt to take it into sudden death against Tyler Daniel, the reigning champion. After three holes, Bo Jay birdied to win the tournament!

Tell everyone, with a wink of your eye: "Bo Jay must be enjoying his victory celebration a little too much. That is why he's not here yet!"

Around members and guests, you should not show any animosity against Bo Jay, even though you despise him deeply. Remember you sponsored his membership!

Give Sandy a pat on the back and tell her "to get her camera ready for a few fireworks tonight! The members and guests seem a little restless."

Reprimand Mow for wearing his muddy work shoes to serve at the party, even though you are pretty sure that he has no other shoes. Tell him "to go and clean them up!"

**This clue should be revealed to others.**

## Round 1 Clue for Ophelia Payne Golf Trivia & Reveal Clue

Ask the following question to the first guests you meet:

Question: At what age did Michelle Wie begin playing golf?

Answer: Age 4

### REVEAL CLUES:

Mingle with everyone and reveal how happy you are that the underdog won the tournament, but don't let Tyler hear you. Tell them it reminds you of your days on the tour when you won lots of tournaments in sudden death playoffs. How exciting it was to have everyone clamoring for your autograph!

Compliment Crissy on her attire and tell her you think that Bo Jay will sure be sorry she left him.

You wonder if Bo Jay ever found Judge Wiff after the match...He was dead set on finding him!

You are sure sorry that Tyler lost the tournament, because he sure played a great game. You will make sure he's a winner tonight!

Rave about Hal Tuplay's newfangled putter...There is always something in it for you!

## Round 1 Clue for Judge Wifford Wintergreen III Golf Trivia & Reveal Clue

With your noted joke telling inabilities tell this one to anyone that will listen:

A Catholic Priest rushed from confessions at church one day to keep a golf date. He was halfway down the first fairway, waiting to hit his second shot, when he heard "FORE!" and a ball slammed into his back. Soon, the golfer who made the drive was on the scene to offer his apologies. When the priest assured him that he was all right, the man smiled. "Thank God, Father!" he exclaimed, "I've been playing this game for 40 years, and now I can finally tell my buddies that I hit my first holy one!"

### REVEAL CLUES:

Mingle with the guests during this round and accomplish the following:

You are disappointed in Tyler's loss...you don't trust Bo Jay's golf ethics and you feel that he is already a detriment to the club! Rant on about the club losing face by allowing all these high income, low-class street people into your club!

Chip was caddying for Bo Jay...You wonder if it's true that Bo Jay improved his lie in the rough on #17. If so, he should be DQ'd immediately and Tyler should win!

Ask Roger: "Did your attire come from a costume shop or do you shop at Goodwill?"

Be extra attentive to Ivana!

## Round 1 Clue for Sandy Beigher Golf Trivia & Reveal Clue

Ask the following question to the first guest you meet:

Question: What famous female golf professional was named "Taco" in high school?

Answer: Nancy Lopez

---

### REVEAL CLUES:

Mingle around the room making small talk and taking pictures of everyone. Make sure you are included in some pictures!

You know that Tyler is the better player and if you could change the outcome you would. Reveal to anyone around that several years ago, Bo Jay lied regarding your ex-husband, Juan Tuplay in a tournament, by saying he cheated when he truly did not! Nobody wanted to question the celebrity, so Juan was disqualified and Bo Jay won! You don't think that Bo Jay is idolized anymore, so if there is a question of his cheating, let's expose it!

What do you think Crissy thinks of Bo Jay winning the tournament despite his obvious anger at her dumping him. Maybe she would reconsider and take him back now that he's the club champion. It could be another means of enhancing her publicity that her agent is always seeking.

Maybe you should take Ophelia's picture with Bo Jay when he arrives.

Get Wiff and Roger together for a picture and tell them you are writing an article for the Snobwood Snoop on how opposites attract!

**This clue should be revealed to others.**

## Round 1 Clue for Roger Rancor Golf Trivia & Reveal Clue

Ask the following question to the first guests you meet:

Question: In the 1960s, what two golfers led the PGA in earnings three out of ten seasons each?

Answer: Arnold Palmer and Jack Nicklaus

### REVEAL CLUES:

In this round, mingle with everybody and accomplish these things:

Ask everybody in general: "Where in the heck is the fricken winner?"

Wiff looks like he pilfered his rags off of a corpse!

Exclaim to Honey and anybody else around: "If Bo Jay ever tries to hustle my chick, I'll show that buzzard a grip and choke that will forever impede his line of play!"

Lee seems to have the heebie-jeebies... Did another one of his real estate deals fail or was it another poker loss?

Looking at Ivana, if you didn't know better, you'd think she got a special surprise.

In front of everyone, ask Chip how much Bo Jay tipped him and tell him you would have tripled it at the very least!
